Hello Theresetta Community,

Thank you for your patience during these trying and difficult times. The staff of Theresetta is endeavouring to continue a quality education for your children. To this end, staff will be assembling necessary core-subject student materials and resources (texts, scribbles, duotangs, binders, etc) for pick up this afternoon and the remainder of the week from 9:00 to 3:00 if necessary.

In order to comply with health authority and government recommendations, minimize contact and respect social distancing measures, Grades 1-3 materials will be available for pick up from the north or grade K-3 doors. Grade 4-6 student materials should be picked up through the middle door's entrance. Junior high materials are to be picked up at the south, junior high doors. If you have students in multiple grades or classrooms, we will place your family's items with the youngest child's materials to allow for a quicker, easier stop at the school. If, once you are home, you find we have forgotten items, please inform us and we will endeavour to find them and arrange an alternate pick up. As well, library books could be dropped off in the respective boot rooms.

At this time, we are awaiting information on recommended methods for delivery of student learning. When this is decided upon, I will notify you as to these new procedures.

We will also place items from our lost and found bins on the sidewalks in front of the school today. Please have a look for your family's items upon arrival at the school.
